What is Zakat?

Zakat is a key pillar of Islam, requiring muslims to give a portion of their wealth to help the poor and needy.

It purifies one's wealth, fosters social justice, and ensures that resources are shared fairly.

Unlike charity done for selfsatisfaction, Zakat is given solely for the sake of Allah, making it a truly moral deed.

By focusing on pleasing Allah, rather than personal gain, Zakat reflects the purest form of compassion and generosity.
